**Dr Reddy's** on Monday said it has entered into an agreement with Russian drugmaker Binnopharm Group to sell two of its anti-bacterial brands **Ciprolet** and **Levolet** in Russia, Belarus and Uzbekistan.

The portfolio includes various dosage forms such as tablets, solutions for

infusions, and eye drops.

Dr Reddy's didn't specify the financial details of the sale.
